

## At the Airport

### 1. Warm-up Discussion Questions

1. Have you been to an airport before?
2. What do you usually bring in your carry-on bag?
3. How do you feel about flying on a plane?
4. What information do you need to check before boarding a flight?
5. What do you say when you need help finding your gate?
6. How do you ask about the time for boarding or departure?

## 2. Example Conversation: At the Airport

**Student A (Passenger):** Hello! Can you help me, please?

**Student B (Airport Staff):** Sure! How can I help you?

**Student A:** I need to find Gate 12. Where is it?

**Student B:** Gate 12 is this way. Follow the signs for Gates 10 to 15.

**Student A:** Thank you. What time does boarding start?

**Student B:** Your boarding time is at 2:30 p.m.

**Student A:** Great! And my flight departs at 3:00 p.m., right?

**Student B:** Yes, that's correct.

**Student A:** Do I need to show my passport at the gate?

**Student B:** Yes, you will need your passport and boarding pass.

**Student A:** Thank you! Where can I get some water?

**Student B:** There is a café right next to Gate 12.

**Student A:** Perfect. And where is the restroom, please?

**Student B:** The restroom is around the corner, to the left.

**Student A:** Thank you very much for your help!

**Student B:** You're welcome! Have a great flight!

**Student A:** Thank you! Goodbye!

**Student B:** Goodbye!

### 3. Background

Student A is a traveler at the airport who needs help finding their gate and getting other basic information before boarding. Student B is an airport staff member, helping Student A with directions and information.

### 4. Instructions

#### **Student A (Passenger):**

Ask the airport staff for help finding your gate. Ask about your boarding time, if you need to show your passport, and where to find water and the restroom.

#### **Student B (Airport Staff):**

Help Student A find their gate and give them the boarding information they need. Answer any questions Student A has about the airport facilities.
