1. Warm-up Discussion Questions

- 1. Do you like going to restaurants?
- 2. What's your favorite type of food to order?
- 3. Do you know how to order food in English?
- 4. What are some words you use to describe food (e.g., hot, sweet)?
- 5. How do you ask for the menu in a restaurant?
- 6. How do you ask for the bill when you're finished?

2. Example Conversation: Ordering Food at a Restaurant

Student A (Waiter): Hello! Welcome to our restaurant. Here is the menu.

Student B (Customer): Thank you! I'd like to order, please.

Student A: Sure! What would you like?

Student B: I'd like a cheese pizza, please.

Student A: Okay. Would you like a drink with that?

Student B: Yes, I'll have a glass of water, please.

Student A: Alright. Would you like anything else?

Student B: Yes, can I have a salad too?

Student A: Of course. Is that all?

Student B: Yes, that's all for now. Thank you!

Student A: Great! I'll bring your order soon.

Student B: Thank you very much.

(Later)

Student A: Here's your food. Enjoy your meal!

Student B: Thank you. Can I have the bill, please?

Student A: Sure. Here it is.

Student B: Thanks. Have a nice day!

Student A: You too! Goodbye!

3. Background

Student B is visiting a restaurant and wants to order a meal. Student A is the waiter who will take their order, answer questions, and provide the bill at the end.

4. Instructions

Student A (Waiter):

You are the waiter. Greet the customer and give them the menu. Take their order, ask if they would like a drink or anything extra, and respond politely. When they ask for the bill, give it to them and thank them.

Student B (Customer):

You are the customer. Look at the menu, choose a main dish, a drink, and something extra. Politely tell the waiter your order and ask for the bill when you are done.
