

## Talking About the Weather

CEFR A1 Roleplay



### 1. Warm-up Discussion Questions

1. What is the weather like today?
2. Do you prefer sunny or rainy weather?
3. What activities do you like to do when it's sunny?
4. What activities do you do when it's rainy?
5. Do you like cold weather or warm weather more?
6. How do you usually check the weather (e.g., phone, TV, window)?

## 2. Example Conversation: Talking About the Weather

**Student A:** Hello! How's the weather today?

**Student B:** Hi! It's sunny and warm. I think it's about 25 degrees.

**Student A:** That's nice! I like sunny days.

**Student B:** Me too. Do you like hot weather?

**Student A:** Yes, but not too hot. Around 25 degrees is perfect for me.

**Student B:** Same here! Do you like winter weather?

**Student A:** Winter is okay, but I don't like it when it's too cold. What about you?

**Student B:** I like winter when there's snow. Snow is fun!

**Student A:** Yes, snow is nice. But I prefer spring because it's not too hot or too cold.

**Student B:** Spring is lovely! Do you like rainy days?

**Student A:** Sometimes. Rain is good for plants, but I don't like going out in the rain.

**Student B:** I understand. Rainy days are good for staying home and reading.

**Student A:** Yes! Do you check the weather every day?

**Student B:** Yes, I check it on my phone in the morning.

**Student A:** Good idea! It was nice talking about the weather.

**Student B:** Yes, it was! See you later!

### 3. Background

Student A and Student B meet in a park and start talking about the weather. They discuss their preferences for different types of weather and activities they enjoy doing in each season.

### 4. Instructions

#### **Student A:**

Greet Student B and ask about the weather today. Talk about what weather you like, what seasons you enjoy, and ask questions about what Student B likes.

#### **Student B:**

Greet Student A and describe the weather today. Talk about what weather and seasons you like, what activities you do in different weather, and answer Student A's questions.
