1. Warm-up Discussion:

- 1. Have you ever been on a group holiday? What was your experience like?
- 2. What are the key factors to consider when planning a holiday with a group of people?
- 3. How do you usually decide on a destination when traveling with others?
- 4. What are the potential challenges of organizing a group holiday?
- 5. How can you ensure that everyone's preferences are taken into account when planning activities?
- 6. What strategies can you use to manage the budget for a group holiday?

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2. Example Conversation: Organizing a Group Holiday
